GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

WATER CRISIS CONTRIBUTION IN CAPE TOWN

Bryanston Primary is joining the initiative to collect SEALED 5l bottles of water for those in need in Cape Town.

We have partnered up with Sunningdale Primary as a point of delivery for the water that is collected. The school will be able to store and allocate the water.

Our hope is to collect 10 litres of water from each child (2 x 5l bottles). This is not a compulsory contribution, but we would appreciate any assistance in this regard.

We will collect water over the month of February, and it will be transported to Sunningdale Primary (Cape Town) once we have collected the amount stipulated by the logistics company.

Please note that all the bottles need to be SEALED to reduce the risk of contamination and any form of illness. Please ensure that the water is not bottled in any springs from the Western Cape, to reduce the pressure on their water table.

GETTING STARTED

Download the installer from the School Communicator website: www.school-communicator.com/downloads. While downloading click "save" and thereafter "run". You can also install the d6 School Communicator on your mobile phone; visit the website from your mobile phone browser and download the app.

HOW WILL THE SCHOOL COMMUNICATOR AFFECT YOUR COMPUTER?

The School Communicator is a lightweight application and should have no noticeable impact on your computer. In some instances you might need to change your anti-virus or firewalls settings to allow the School Communicator to run.

BANDWIDTH

The School Communicator typically uses about 30Mb of data a month.

PRIVACY

Any personal information shared with the School Communicator (including your registration details) is absolutely private, and may only be used by the school. It may not be sold or shared with any third party. The School Communicator servers are protected by Thawte to ensure no unauthorised access of your details.

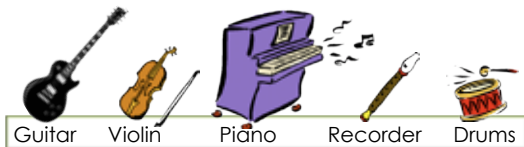
